

Sign & Sing Session A/Village:

Tuesday, 9:00-9:45 AM, Jan. 17 – May 8 (no class Feb. 28 & April 24)

Wednesday, 10:30-11:15 AM, Jan. 18 – May 9 (no class Feb. 29 & April 25)

This semester we will be offering a combination 6-week Sign & Sing program followed by an 8-week Village program. We will be incorporating the “signs” learned in Sign & Sing into the Village program that follows.

Kindermusik Sign & Sing (6 months-18 months) is a curriculum that offers parents and caregivers techniques for communicating with children through American Sign Language (ASL) signs and singing. *Sign & Sing* differs from other sign language programs in that not only do parents learn how to form signs, but they also learn how to integrate signs naturally into everyday interactions with their children. Children meet each week with a parent or caregiver for a 45-minute class of playful songs and activities that help parents become comfortable with signing. These shared activities help nurture healthy families by fostering intimacy, communication, and learning between parents and children. After a few classes, you'll see how your child is more easily soothed and less frustrated when he can say what he wants – if it's more of his favorite game, or he's tired, or he's all done!

Materials include a family activity guide, glossary DVD, and first signs flashcards.

Note: Sign & Sing may be offered to children up to age 3 but for this particular session will be offered as a combination class to Village age children only.

Kindermusik Village (newborn - 18 months) provides a wonderful learning and bonding experience for you and your baby. Through a unique blend of multi-level activities that include creative movement, vocal play, object and instrument exploration, your baby's growth and development are stimulated and all of his/her senses engaged. This 45-minute class is for lap babies, crawlers, and walkers accompanied by a parent or caregiver.

Cock-doodle-MOO! explores a farm theme through music, motion and multi-sensory activities. Baby will enjoy the movement of a “hayride,” and experience vocal play by using farm animal sounds.

Materials include a home CD, baby's literature book, instrument, and art banners.

Our Time:

Kindermusik Our Time (18 months - 3-1/2 years) is a class created for you and your child to celebrate the wondrous time of connection and discovery. This class integrates music, movement, and literacy using developmentally appropriate methods in an environment that fosters creative growth at an individual pace. *Our Time* is offered in four non-sequential, 15-week semesters. Children meet each week with a parent or caregiver for a 45-minute class of singing, chanting, listening, moving, dancing, interacting socially, and simple instrument playing. *Away We Go!* guides parent and child to explore the exciting world of things that go through this transportation adventure and discovery of trains, cars, buses, horses, wagons, airplanes and boats!

Materials include children's train carry box, two home CD's, two story books (*Shiny Dinah* and *Giddy-Up!*), home activity book, and two harmonicas.

Imagine That:

Kindermusik Imagine That! (3 - 5 years) takes your independent child (without a parent) on a musical journey of discovery and exploration by the power of imagination. This program will be offered in four, non-sequential, 15-week semesters. Each 45-minute lesson combines a blend of music, singing, movement, literature, and pretend play. This stimulating classroom experience provides opportunities for new discoveries and encourages each child to play an active and expressive role by reflecting, comparing, making choices, expressing opinions and problem solving. *Toys I Make, Trips I Take* leads the child on a magical journey into a remarkable Toy Shop filled with boats, trains, balls, jack-in-the-box and many other toys that bring a glimmer into a child's eyes. While the excitement may begin in the toy shop, it may end on a tropical island. *Imagine That!* Parents or caregivers are actively involved in the last 10-15 minutes of each lesson.

Materials include two home CD's, family activity book, drum, play set, two story books (*If I Had a Big Blue Boat* and *Tippity Tippity Too!*), and a backpack. (The backpack will be used in all four semesters.) Materials can also be ordered without the backpack if you already have a Kindermusik backpack or substitute backpack.

Kindermusik Family Time (newborn - 7 years) is a multi-age program designed for multi-child families who want to experience the joys of music and learning while having fun together. Each family is encouraged to participate in whatever way is most suitable for the ages of its particular children. *Family Time* has something for everyone: babies, preschoolers, and parents alike will sing, dance, and play while learning - from the music, and from each other! Single-child families are welcome to participate as well. *Family Time* is a 15-week program where families meet each week for a 45-minute class. In one semester you'll see how music helps your family laugh together, share, take turns, and how musical learning really can be a family thing.

In *Make Way for Music*, families will sing, dance, and move their way through an exploration of several elements of music: beat and rhythm, concepts and contrasts (such as staccato and legato, high and low, the major scale, and arpeggios), the human voice, instrument families, and ensemble.

Materials include two home CD's, two finger drums, two Jellybean Band books with activity pages, two storybooks (*Drum Circle* and *Animals on Parade*), a matching card game, and *Sing, Play, & Grow! A family guide to musical fun*—a book full of activities and information about child development, as well as fun facts about the songs enjoyed in class.

Only one set of materials is required for each family.

Young Child 2:

Kindermusik for the Young Child (4-1/2 - 7 years) is a music curriculum designed to provide readiness for the young child who is eager for first experiences with musical symbols and instrumental discovery. Young Child is a sequential program divided into four 15-week semesters. Each weekly one-hour lesson provides an opportunity for singing and vocal development, rhythm, creative movement, listening, playing simple percussion instruments, exploring musical concepts, learning the elements of reading and writing musical notation, and ensemble development. *Semester 2* further develops the child's instrument-playing skills while developing the greatest instrument of all – the voice! Pressure free, developmentally appropriate concepts help effectively prepare children for formal music instruction after age seven. Parents or caregivers join the class for a “sharing time” at the end of each lesson.

Materials for Semester 2 include a children's folder, games bag, family songbook, and home CD.
